Limited parking is available at the yacht club until 4:00 p.m. After 4:00 p.m. overflow parking is at Chesapeake High School. Buses from the school will provide transportation to the event site. Admission is \$ 2 .00 per person.

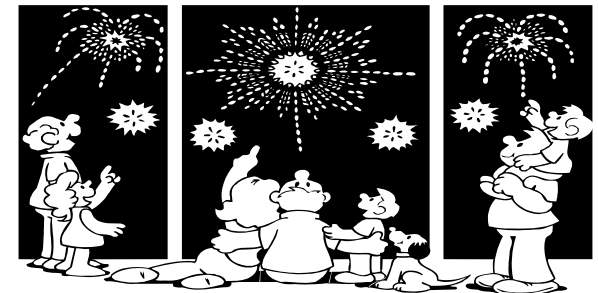
